Speaker Biography

Professor Craig White

Craig is Divisional Clinical Lead in the Quality and Planning Division of the Healthcare Quality and Strategy Directorate, Scottish Government. He is a clinical and health psychologist. He has doctoral degrees in clinical psychology and psychological medicine and recently completed his Masters in Medical Law. He is a Founding Fellow of the Academy of Cognitive Therapy, a Fellow of the British Psychological Society and Fellow of the Royal College of Physicians of Edinburgh. He is Honorary Professor in the College of Medicine, Veterinary and Life Sciences at the University of Glasgow.



Craig has held several clinical, management and academic posts within Scotland, including Lead Clinician for Palliative Care in NHS Ayrshire and Arran. He currently leads for the Scottish Government work on a range of areas spanning governance and improvement, most recently working on adverse events, complaints, feedback, clinical governance and duty of candour. Craig Chairs the National Advisory Group for Palliative and End of Life Care.
