Dr Elaine Boland

Elaine Boland has been a consultant in palliative medicine in Hull and East Riding Hospitals since 2012. She qualified in medicine from the University of Malta in 2002, and did her general medical training and MRCP before coming to the UK in 2006. She worked in oncology and then as a SpR in palliative medicine in Sheffield. For her PhD she studied central nervous system pain processing of chemotherapy-induced peripheral neuropathy in patients with multiple myeloma as well as assessing their quality of life and symptom burden.

She is currently developing the services for patients with non-malignant diseases in Hull and East Riding and is an Honorary Senior Lecturer at Hull York Medical School.

She is an elected member of the Science Committee for the Association of Palliative Medicine and is deputy associate editor for the journal Supportive Care in Cancer.
